FUNDRAISER OPTION

You may choose to sell these items at cost or use this as a fundraising opportunity. Even with fundraiser prices, pricing for all items is still well below retail costs. **Example of fundraiser pricing structure:**

Compost Bins - sell at \$73 and make \$5 each, **Rain Barrels** - sell at \$77 and make \$5 each, **Kitchen Pails** - sell at \$13 and make \$2 each, **Compost Turners** - sell at \$29 and make \$2 each.

SHIPPING REQUIREMENTS

- All orders will be shipped directly to your requested location.
- Truck will deliver items on pallets and will get the pallet to the end of the truck.
- If you do not have the ability to unload the pallets off the truck (forklift, loading dock, or folks available to assist in unloading): we can arrange that service for a flat \$50.00 charge.
- Deliveries will be prearranged with you and will occur approximately between May 13 - May 21, 2022. You will be contacted prior to delivery to coordinate. You will then be able to distribute the orders to your community.

COMPOST BINS

In 2018, approximately 146.1 million tons of MSW were landfilled, with food being the largest component at about 24% and yard waste at about 7%, according to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). The use of backyard composting systems by residents can help divert this waste and while benefitting from fresh compost.
