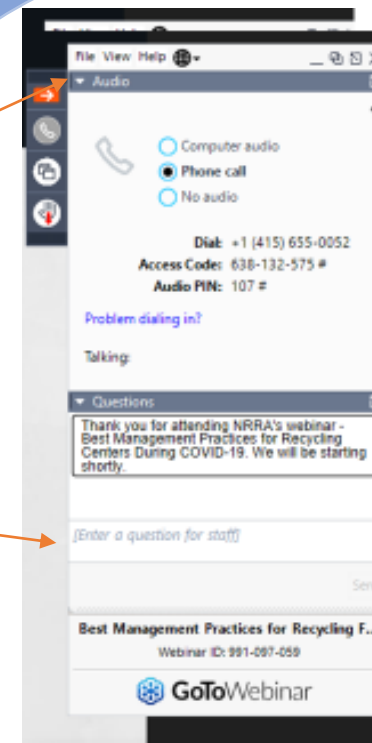

Fast Fashion

- a \$2.5 Trillion Industry (Annually)
- 5th Most Polluting Industry Globally
- Toxic Textile Dyes
- 2nd Largest Water Polluter Globally
- Labor Exploitation (85% Women)
- 700 Gallons of Water to Manufacture One Shirt
- Textile Waste is 8% of Americas Total Waste Stream

THE PROBLEM

People

- 11.2 Million Tons Thrown Out (Landfill)
- Average American Disposes of 70 Pounds Annually
- Average American Purchases 37 NEW Items Annually
- Only 16% of Americans Buy Used Clothing
- Only 15% of Americans Recycle Clothing
- 85% of All Clothing, Shoes and Textiles Discarded
